JANUARY BHRC STATEMENTS

SRI LANKA: Impeachment of Chief Justice

On the 2nd January, the BHRC voiced its concern at the circumstances surrounding the impeachment motion of the Chief Justice of Sri Lanka, Shirani Bandaranayake, and at reports of attacks against the judiciary and the legal profession in that country. To access the BHRC Press Release click here.

INDIA: Bar Council and BHRC joint statement of concern

On the 7th January, the Bar Council and the BHRC released a joint statement expressing concern at reports that the Saket Bar Association and the Delhi Bar Association have resolved not to represent the men charged with rape and murder of a 23 year old student. SRI LANKA: Further Statement on Impeachment of Chief Justice

On the 17th January, the BHRC released a further statement raising concerns at the decision of the President of Sri Lanka, Mr Mahinda Rajapaksa, to remove the Chief of Justice of that country following a parliamentary procedure which the Supreme Court ruled to be unconstitutional. TURKEY: A further 15 Turkeys lawyers arrested

On the 19th January, the BHRC released an statement expressing concern at the arrest of a further 15 lawyers in Turkey on the 16th January 2013. The lawyers arrested are known for their work in representing persons accused of crimes against the state and terrorism, and members of minorities. This recent arrest follows the arrest in November 2011 of 46 lawyers who are now being prosecuted on charges alleging association with a terrorist organisation.
